

Menominee Regional Public Transit COVID-19 Updates

In response to the recent Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak and the declaration of state of emergency by the Menominee Indian Tribe, all non-medical related transportation services to hot spot counties will be cancelled for the next 45 days. Current routes affected include:

Green Bay
Fox Cities
Milwaukee

All services (regular fixed routes, demand response and medical) are currently operating on the Reservation as well as fixed routes and medical routes to the City of Shawano.

Per Public Health Officer-Dr. Amy Slagle's instruction a rider who is coughing or showing other signs of illness must use a mask while riding public transportation. Drivers will have masks on hand to provide to individuals at their discretion. If a rider will not wear a mask when asked, the driver has the right to refuse transportation and this individual will need to find other means of transportation. This requirement applies to riders of all ages.

This procedure will remain in effect until masks are no longer available.

Menominee Regional Public Transit is also taking extra precautions to sanitize all vehicles used for transport. Passengers can be assured we are doing everything we can to minimize the risk of exposure.
